Students answer questions (trivia style) from all areas of academics: mathematics, science, social studies, english, etc.

Students practice weekly with a coach (FHSU professor) and will compete against other colleges within the state of KS and at the national level. This year, the regional competition is located at Pittsburg State University in Pittsburg, KS. The national competition (which FHSU usually qualifies for and does well), is located in Baltimore, MD. 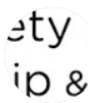
