



Introducing Automated Feedback

Improve the academic writing of students with instant feedback powered by AI

What is Automated Feedback?

A tool that provides formative feedback on students lower-order skills based on criteria set by teachers. The feedback allows for students to improve the quality of their assignments with minimum teacher set-up effort. As a result, the teachers reviewing workload is reduced and student learning is encouraged by allowing instant, actionable feedback at the right moment.

How does Automated Feedback work?

Automated Feedback serves as a component to stimulate existing pedagogical feedback processes; feedback criteria can be configured to meet the needs of the teacher and the students. Moreover, full transparency is provided with testing upfront with previous submissions by using the try out feature, and monitoring class progress after students' submissions.

Why should I use Automated Feedback?

This tool:

- **Improve students' writing quality** and **promotes initiative** to do their own proofreading
- **Reduce teacher reviewing time** by minimizing repetitive feedback and allowing them to focus on guiding students on the content
