

Candidates must live and work in one of the following designated Northwest Kansas areas for two consecutive years of full-time employment in the role of their new degree:



### DANE G. HANSEN FORGIVABLE LOAN

Applications for the Dane G. Hansen Foundation Forgivable Loan will include:

- A 1-2 page, typed essay in 7th edition APA format explaining why you want to live in Northwest Kansas and the job where you intend to be employed.
- 2. A letter of support from your advisor.
- 3. A letter of intent from a future employer.
- 4. This is a competitive application process. If selected to continue in the Dane G. Hansen Forgivable Loan process, students will be contacted for an interview, in person or by video, with the scholarship committee.
- 5. Once the scholarship committee has determined the qualifi ed recipients, chosen students for the Forgivable Loan will be notifi ed.
- 6. Application deadline is MAY 20th.





### **APPLICATION CRITERIA**

- All application materials (essay, letter of support from advisor, letter of intent from future employer) must be submitted to almeder@fhsu.edu by May 20th.
- Must be currently enrolled full or part time at FHSU in the Nursing Department
- Must be a resident of a designated Northwest Kansas county

The Dane G. Hansen Forgivable Loan will forgive the loan of chosen student recipients upon submission of evidence that two consecutive years of full-time employment have been completed in a designated Northwest Kansas healthcare setting. This is a competitive application.
