

## CEA STUDY ABROAD: Program Model Descriptions

<p><b>COURSE LOCATION</b> Where will students take their courses? On a university campus or at an independent location?</p>	Students will take their courses at a CEA Study Center. They will take courses with other U.S. study abroad students.	Students will take courses at one of CEA's international partner universities. They will take classes alongside local and international students.	Students will take some of their courses at a CEA Study Center and other courses at one of the partner universities in that city.
<p><b>INSTRUCTORS FOR COURSES</b> Who will be teaching the courses? Faculty hired by the Provider or Faculty at a university?</p>	Courses are taught by faculty hired by CEA. Courses are taught in English, but there are also foreign language courses available with some Study Center programs.	Courses are taught by university faculty. Courses are generally taught in English, but students may choose to take foreign language courses or content courses taught in the host language depending on availability and their foreign language proficiency.	Courses are taught both by faculty hired by CEA and faculty at our partner universities.
<p><b>COURSE AVAILABILITY</b> Are students limited on what courses they can take? Are there only certain courses available at the Study Centers?</p>	Students may choose from the available courses at the CEA Study Center. These courses and their syllabi are listed on the CEA website.	Course options depend on the program. Some international partner programs have a specific subset of courses designated for visiting students. Other programs will give CEA students access to their full course catalog.	Students will be able to choose courses both from a CEA Study Center and one of the partner universities in that same city.
<p><b>STUDY CENTER LOCATIONS</b> How many different Study Center locations are available?</p>	There are 8 CEA Study Center locations: Buenos Aires, Barcelona, Dublin, Florence, Paris, Prague, Rome, and Seville	CEA offers partner university programs in 21 different cities in 12 countries.	Hybrid programs are available in: Buenos Aires, Barcelona, Dublin, Florence, Paris, Prague, Rome, Seville
<p><b>HOUSING OPTIONS</b> Who will they live with...other American students, other international students? Will they live on-campus, off-campus?</p>	Housing options are generally the same regardless of the type of program that students select. The only exception is that students participating in an international partner program or hybrid program may have a residence hall housing option available through that respective university (this depends on each individual program). Housing options vary across our different programs, and students can find descriptions and locations of each of our housing options on the website.		

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<b>MEAL PLAN OPTIONS</b> Are meals provided, do they pay for their own meals	Meal plan options will vary across CEA’s different program locations. Within each housing description it will indicate whether meals are included or if this is an additional expense.		
<b>CULTURAL ACTIVITIES OPTIONS</b> Are these available to students with both program models? Is the cost different?	<p>The cultural activities organized by CEA are the same for all three different program models, and all students will have access to these cultural activities throughout their term abroad. The cost is the same and is included in the overall program price.</p> <p>For students choosing an international partner or hybrid program option, there may be <i>additional</i> programming available to these students. These may be at no cost or carry a fee. It will depend on each university/activity.</p>		
<b>OPTIONAL EXCURSIONS OPTIONS</b> Are these available to students with both program models? Is the cost different?	<p>The excursions organized by CEA are the same for all three different program models, and all students are encouraged to participate in these excursions. The cost is the same and is included in the overall program price.</p> <p>For students choosing an international partner or hybrid program option, there may be <i>additional</i> programming available to these students. These may be at no cost or carry a fee. It will depend on each university/activity.</p>		
<b>ON-SITE STAFF</b> Who is available to students? How much oversight will be given to students?	For all CEA programs and destinations, there is a staff on site who will support students during their time abroad. These individuals are responsible for CEA’s airport pick-up service, cultural activities and excursions, health and safety, and general personal and academic support for students. This is one advantage of participating in a CEA program – students will have access to a great amount of support, but if they are seeking an immersive, independent experience abroad, they can still achieve that on a CEA program. CEA Enrollment Specialists work with students to identify the best program fit for students based on their academic and personal needs and interests.
