Meet with your academic advisor and faculty mentor to discuss concerns about your current major.

- Discuss what you like and dislike about your current major .

- Using the FHSUMajors inventory results, explore majors of interest .
- Compare curriculums from different academic departments.
- Meet with faculty in academic departments you find interesting.

Schedule an appointment to meet with a career advisor in the AACE Center.
