TRANSITION TO TEACHING (T2T):

Available for licensure in:

Most all middle school and secondary licensure areas.

- Must hold a bachelor's degree or higher in one of the above areas or have equivalent coursework in the area for which the restricted license is sought.
- Minimum GPA of 2.75 on the most recent 60 credit hours.
- Available 100% online at the graduate level.
- Must pass Praxis content exam in qualified area to start the program.
- 24 credit hours for licensure; optional MSE degree available for an additional 12 credit hours.
- Must be hired as teacher of record in Kansas for the area qualified for; no student teaching required.
- 2 years to complete the program.

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN EDUCATION - SECONDARY EDUCATION:

Available for licensure in:

- Biology
- Business
- Chemistry
- Earth and Space Science
- Foreign Languages
- History
- Middle School Science
- Physics
- Must hold a bachelor's degree or higher in one of the above areas or have equivalent coursework in the area for which the license is sought.
- Available 100% online at the graduate level.
- Must pass Praxis content exam in qualified area within first 9 credit hours.
- 27 credit hours for licensure; optional MSE degree available for an additional 9 credit hours.
- Includes one semester of full-time student teaching - can be completed outside of Kansas.
- 2 years to complete the program.

NOYCE POST-BACCALAUREATE SCIENCE PROGRAM:

Available for licensure in:

- Biology
- Chemistry
- Earth and Space Science
- Physics
- Must hold a bachelor's degree or higher in one of the above areas or have equivalent coursework in the area for which the license is sought.
- Available at the graduate level 100% online along with face-to-face occurring at the partner school district.
- Must pass Praxis content exam in qualified area within first 6 credit hours.
- 30 credit hours for licensure; optional MSE degree available for additional 9 credit hrs.
- Will receive a stipend of \$22,000. Must teach 2 years in high-needs school to keep the stipend funds.
- Includes one semester of full-time student teaching to be completed in a high-needs rural school.
- 15 months to complete the program.
