4th Academic Advisor Meeting

Let's touch base and chat about your progress towards major declaration. Meet with us in the first three weeks of the semester to update us on your growth and concerns.

Complete Career Exploration

If you are not registered in UNIV 100: Major and Career Exploration, completion of in-office Career Exploration is a must. Meet one-on-one with a career advisor to work through the research and decision-making process that will have you ready to declare with confidence.

5th Academic Advisor Meeting

Academic progress (interim grades) and major exploration progress will be the topics of discussion. If you are not yet ready to declare, that's OK. We will discuss future options and upcoming registration.

6th Academic Advisor Meeting

Registration will be the focus of this meeting. If you have declared your major, you will meet with your academic advisor for your new major. If you have not declared, you will meet with your AACE Center academic advisor.
