

THE GRADUATE SCHOOL

The United States Department of Education (Federal regulation Sec 668.43 A-C) requires Fort Hays State University (FHSU) to contact applicants who are interested in programs that lead to state licensure or certification. We are required to notify you if the program you are interested in will meet educational requirements to apply for certification or licensure in your home state.

The only state that FHSU is designating as "Meets" currently is Kansas. All other states and territories have a designation of "Does Not Meet", because a determination has not been made. You may still enroll in your selected program, providing that the below statements are signed.

## 1. LOCATION DIRECT DISCLOSURE:

Because you may reside in a state designated as "Does Not Meet" educational requirements for licensure at the time of your initial application to FHSU, you must provide an attestation statement prior to enrollment and receipt of financial aid at FHSU.
