

President's Distinguished Scholar Committee

PURPOSE:	Considers applications and nominations, and recommend recipient(s) for the President's Distinguished Scholar Award.
MEMBERSHIP:	<ul style="list-style-type: none">• Officers<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Chaired by the Provost. The Chairperson shall be the presiding officer and shall administer all business of the committee• Faculty representatives<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Committee consists of the five most recent years' President's Distinguished Scholar Award recipients.
HOW APPOINTED:	Only previous recipients of the award are eligible.
ROTATION:	Previous years' recipients will serve, rotating off each year as the most recent recipient is added with a maximum of five members.
WHEN APPOINTED:	Members will be appointed in the spring semester and take their seats at the first meeting of the subsequent academic year.
MEETING FREQUENCY:	The committee shall meet as necessary to conduct the business of the committee.
PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE	Quorum shall be met when a simple majority, that is 50% of the committee plus one, is present. No business can be conducted without a quorum present.
