Fort Hays State University welcomes applications for admission from qualified international students.

Application Fee to apply to Fort Hays State University is \$50 non-refundable

International students must certify the necessary funds are available to cover all necessary living and educational expenses for the entire period of proposed study. Projected educational costs for the 2024-2025 calendar year are \$27,513 based on 12 credit hours per semester. Additional credits will increase this cost. A breakdown of costs is listed below.
