ACADEMY OF MATHEMATICS & SCIENCE (AMS) AT FORT HAYS STATE UNIVERSITY

It is understood and assumed that applicants are currently enrolled in school in a grade equivalent to the U.S. tenth grade. Students enrolling at the Academy are expected to complete our two-year program, leading to a high school diploma issued by Thomas More Prep-Marian High School and completion documents from AMS. Students also have the opportunity to complete an Associate's degree from Fort Hays State University.

Academic Preparedness & Minimum Requirements to Apply:

- Completion of 10th grade of high school (required)
- Completion of high school-level Algebra II and Geometry (required)
- Completion of an official English test score is required for all international students applying to Fort
 Hays State University and Academy of Mathematics and Science. Candidates must have ONE of the
 following minimum English test scores for admission to FHSU:
 - TOEFL score 70
 - TOEFL iBT score of 78
 - IELTS (International English Language Testing System) score of 6.0
 - iTEP score of 3.8
 - Duolingo score of 95
 - International students enrolled in an accredited US high school are eligible to waive the language requirement if they have a 2.5 GPA and have taken academically required courses, including two years of English.
- Complete pre-calculus and/or other science and math courses (recommended, not required)

Financial Requirements for Undergraduate International Students

Fort Hays State University welcomes applications for admission from qualified international students.

Application Fee to apply to Fort Hays State University is \$50 non-refundable

International students must certify the necessary funds are available to cover all necessary living and educational expenses for the entire period of proposed study. Projected educational costs for the 2025-2026 calendar year are \$29,272 based on 12 credit hours per semester. Additional credits will increase this cost. A breakdown of costs is listed below.
