

# Certificate in Economic Justice & Advocacy 4 Classes (10 Credit Hours)

The Economic Justice & Advocacy certificate program is designed to provide students with the knowledge and skills needed to advocate for economic justice and equity. Students will complete **ten credit-hours** of courses about poverty and inequality, economic policy, advocacy and activism, and social justice. The certificate program is particularly relevant for students/professionals who plan to work in business, human resources, or social services and volunteer positions. It provides foundational knowledge on supporting employees who have experienced interpersonal violence (IV) and increasing retention through trauma-informed workplace support. By completing this program, students will be equipped with strong written communication skills and knowledge on advocating for economic justice and equity.

#### **Required Courses:**

- CRJ 100 Economic Justice & Advocacy (1 Hour)
- BCOM 210 Introduction to Professional Development
- CRJ 367 Victim Advocacy

# **Choose One of the Following:**

- SOC 664 Social Entrepreneurship and Grassroots Social Action
- SOC 680 Nonprofit Organizations

To obtain this Certificate, students must submit this completed form to the Department of Applied Business Studies. No grade lower than a "C" is acceptable for the classes taken. All courses applied toward the certificate must be taken for credit. Upon completion of certificate requirements, students will receive a certificate in the mail in 2-4 weeks.
