THE ROADMAP TO TEACHER LICENSURE

EARLY FIELD EXPERIENCES

A prerequisite field experience for candidates Secondary majors, are expected to obtain 20 clock hours of observation within placement classroom.

ELEMENTARY AND EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION **INTERNSHIPS**

Elementary and Early Childhood Education candidates will be required to take various internship courses to obtain real-world field experiences before completing their Student Teaching semester. Each internship is between 30-40 clock hours total.



ADMISSION TO STUDENT TEACHING

Candidates must apply for Student Teaching the semester prior to participating. Eligibility begins once all restricted and major courses are completed.





Candidates apply for and obtain their **Teaching License!**





Candidates will need to apply to the **Teacher Education program and be** approved before they can begin taking restricted courses.



SECONDARY FIELD **EXPERIENCES**

Secondary Education candidates will be required to complete 40 clock hours in a classroom within their specific content area. 15 of these hours will be completed in a Special **Education classroom.**



PPAT AND PRAXIS EXAMS

To apply for licensure, candidates must pass the PPAT and Praxis exam(s). The **PPAT** is completed concurrently with the Student Teaching experience while the Praxis is a content exam taken anytime prior to applying for licensure.
