**AP** = Advanced Placement. Typically exams are taken at the end of a high school course

**CLEP** = College Level Examination Program. Exams may be taken by any individual at any scheduled time

**DSST** = Exams may be taken by any individual at any scheduled time

**IB** = International Baccalaureate. These courses are open to high school students in programs approved by International Baccalaureate

**Concurrent & Dual enrollment** – Students may have college credits from these programs. These credits are subject to transfer policies.
