Before applying for admission to Teacher Education, candidates must have a recent test score (within the last six years) on one of the following: a 22 on the ACT in Math, English, and Reading; or 156 on the CORE (CASE) in Reading, 162 in Writing, and 150 in Math. Candidates holding a bachelor's degree are exempt from this testing requirement.

All teacher candidates must complete a full national background check through <https://www.validityacademics.com> prior to completing any field experience or observation in schools. A Field Experiences packet will be given to candidates enrolled in ENG 277 by their instructor and this will need to be completed and submitted to the Field Experience and Licensure Office, Rarick Hall 220.
