**GLOBE DECORATIONS**



These globe decorations are not only a great way to celebrate Geography Awareness week, but also a great way to create homemade ornaments for this upcoming holiday season. Please follow the steps below to complete your globe decorations.

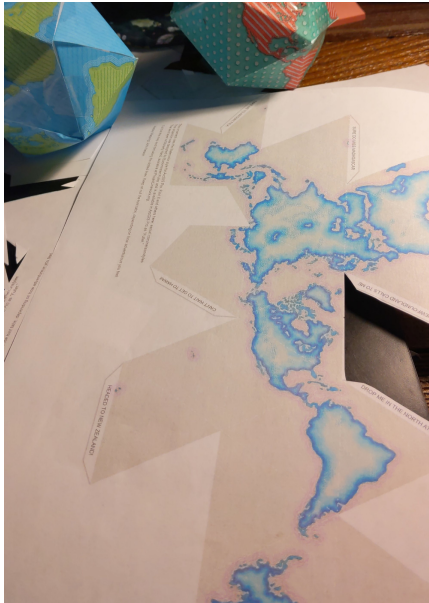
## **STEP ONE: SELECT YOUR PATTERN**

Begin the process by selecting your globe pattern from the three patterns at the end of this document.



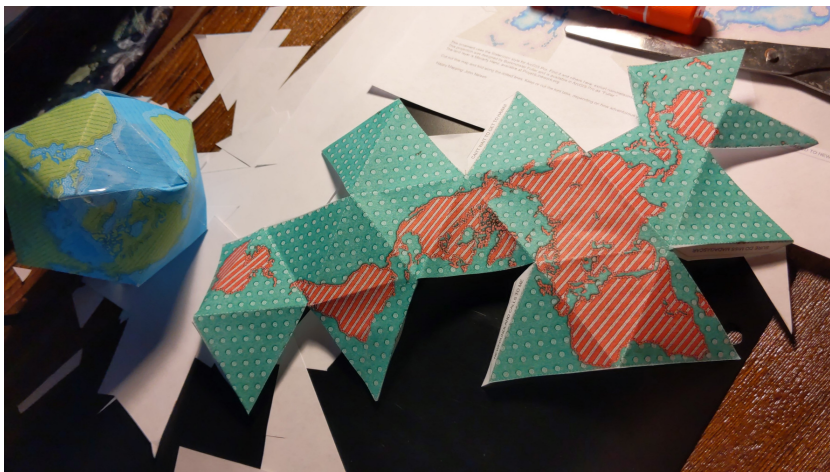
# STEP TWO: CUT OUT THE PATTERN

Cut along the outside edge of the pattern, making sure not to cut off the little trapezoids tabs on the sides of pattern.



# STEP THREE: FOLD

Carefully fold the pattern in all the places that have a light white dotted line. The entire pattern should be made up of triangles.



# STEP FOUR: BEGIN ATTACHING

Carefully begin attaching the tabs to the area they discuss. For example, the tab that says "Can't wait to get to Hawaii" needs to attach to the nearest side of the Hawaiian Islands. You can either glue or tape the globe together. It seems to be the easiest to assemble when you start at the bottom with New Zealand, but will work regardless of where you start.



# STEP FOUR: FINISH

After creating your globe, and attaching all the tabs, there might be a couple places that need extra reinforcement. Carefully attach those spots with a little clear tape. After this you are done. If you wish to make it an ornament, attach some string.
