## **Financial Requirements for Undergraduate International Students**

Fort Hays State University welcomes applications for admission from qualified international students.

\*\*Application Fee to apply to Fort Hays State University is \$50 non-refundable\*\*

International students must certify the necessary funds are available to cover all necessary living and educational expenses for the <a href="mailto:entire">entire</a> period of proposed study. Projected educational costs for the 2025-2026 calendar year are \$29,272 based on 12 credit hours per semester. Additional credits will increase this cost. A breakdown of costs is listed below.
