



Financial Requirements for Undergraduate International Students

Fort Hays State University welcomes applications for admission from qualified international students.

****Application Fee to apply to Fort Hays State University is \$50 non-refundable****

International students must certify the necessary funds are available to cover all necessary living and educational expenses for the entire period of proposed study. Projected educational costs for the 2021-2022 calendar year are \$25,352 based on 12 credit hours per semester. Additional credits will increase this cost. A breakdown of costs is listed below.
