Curricular Practical Training

Are you looking for INTERNSHIP opportunity as a requirement of your academic program of study? If so, you will want to attend one of the CPT Workshops to learn about the process and requirements of CPT an ask questions. Students must be enrolled full-time for at least nine consecutive months prior to application and maintain status.

WORKDAY:

Update Hays Address in Workday ACT NOW S

All international students are required to provide a current mailing address and phone number. It is important that your information stay current at all times as USCIS (U. S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement) requires our office to maintain student records in SEVIS (Student Exchange Visitor Information System). Take a moment to make sure your current mailing address and phone number is updated:

- by logging into Workday
- click your picture or round circle at the top right corner
- click on view profile; this will bring you to a page with a blue navigation bar on the left
- click the Contact link
- click edit for your address
- you will want to ADD an address by clicking the pencil icon at the left of the box; do not change or delete your permanent address from this space. Make sure to check this as your primary address.
- When done, click the check mark at the right corner of the address box.
- Final step is to click SUBMIT at the bottom left
