Organizational Leadership Major Curriculum Guide

The Department of Leadership Studies at Fort Hays State University offers a comprehensive degree in Organizational Leadership. **The Bachelor of Arts/Bachelor of Science Major in Organizational Leadership** is a 36-credit hour interdisciplinary degree, which provides students with an innovative curriculum that focuses on the study of leadership in the context of the modern organization. It examines the theoretical foundation, as well as the practical behaviors and processes that promote positive leadership and organizational development.

The Bachelor's Degree in Organizational Leadership prepares students to become effective organizational players in today's workplace. *Rather than preparing graduates for a single particular career, this liberal arts interdisciplinary degree program provides the knowledge and skills necessary for a broad range of organizational and supervisory positions.* Graduates of the **Bachelor's Degree in Organizational Leadership** find themselves in demand for a wide variety of career choices. Skills such as interpersonal relations, problem solving, team building, collaboration, motivation, communication and change making are all necessary in today's world to successfully operate in the modern workplace.

The purpose of this discipline is to help the learner understand and participate as a leader and follower to improve his or her organization. Organizational Leadership is a broad academic field that is applicable to a variety of collective entities. Some of these entities include private for-profit businesses, public and not-for-profit organizations, large and complex organizations, and small groups and teams. Those who participate in Organizational Leadership have a strong foundation in the theories of leadership and organizational behavior, as well as the competencies and ability to put knowledge into action.

The **Organizational Leadership Major** requires 27 credit hours of core courses and 9 credit hours of major electives. In addition, students are required to complete an additional 12 credit hours of cognate requirements.
