TUITION & FEES POLICY (EFFECTIVE FALL 2008)

Tuition and fees charged will be calculated based on two factors, the type of course (on-campus or off-campus^{*}) and the student's residency status (resident or non-resident).

- A non-resident student will be charged non-resident tuition and fees for both on-campus and offcampus courses.
- A resident student will be charged on-campus rates for on-campus courses, and off-campus rates for off-campus courses.
- Students taking off-campus courses only will pay the off-campus rates.

Contiguous States - Students who are residents of Colorado, Missouri, Nebraska, or Oklahoma qualify for the Contiguous State rate for on-campus courses. The student will pay the higher of the two rates (on-campus Contiguous State or off-campus) for off-campus courses. The FHSU Registrar makes the final determination of eligibility.

*Virtual courses are off-campus courses
