Before You Arrive

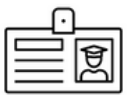
Packing List. On the back are some items you may want to bring with you & some things to leave at home. When thinking about decorations, remember they must be removable without damaging the walls.

Tiger ID. Your Tiger ID will be very important on campus. You will use your Tiger ID to access your building & room. Visit the Card Center in Memorial Union before checking into your room. You are required to provide a state or federally issued ID to get your TigerID card, so be sure to bring it with you!



Parking. If you are bringing a vehicle to campus, parking permits are required. You may request a permit through Workday - myFHSU app, Resources, Parking Permit after August 1st.

- driver's license / ID

eat

- plates, bowls, silverware
- cups / reusable water bottle

- coffeemaker without burner
- cooking supplies to use in community kitchens
- microwave (1000 watt or less)
- refrigerator (max 4.5 cubic ft.)

storage

- laundry basket

what NOT to bring

- air conditioner
- fireworks
