The Field Placement Experience

An important part of graduation requirements for the Bachelor in Social Work is the 500 hour field experience. This is a good opportunity to discover the type of social work you wish to practice upon graduation and to find the type of agency or organization you think will be a good fit with your career goals. The Social Work Program has developed strong partnerships and long-standing relationships with state, local and private agencies throughout Kansas and beyond to find the perfect field experience for you.

Unlike many undergraduate programs, FHSU offers a block placement for your field experience. Rather than a concurrent practicum that lasts an entire academic year while you're still taking classes, you will complete your coursework prior to the field experience. You'll spend 32 hours a week for an entire semester in your placement to give you a better sense of the "real world" work environment and a better chance to apply what you have learned in the classroom. The only class you take will be a three hour professional seminar that accompanies the practicum.
