For KBOR institutions, this will be a pool for SGF-funded positions, as usual. So, it will not apply to non-SGF funded FHSU employees. University leadership has not decided whether they will spend University funds to make this whole for all employees or amortize the 2.5% pool across all employees.

- i) UPS Council/USSC Joint Meeting (Nicole Frank, Les Mackey, Marnie Kohl)
 - (1) Discussion about combined senates versus separated senates. There are still some schools that have separate senates, and they have some questions about how people combine their USS and UPS. One school has separate UPS and USS senates, and their UPS senate caucuses with their faculty senate. Reps discussed elections; we all elect at different times. Some will elect this month like we do and officers next month. Some have already had their elections; others will elect in June and July. Nicole shared that some schools have at-large senators, and our senate might want to consider this idea in the future.
