




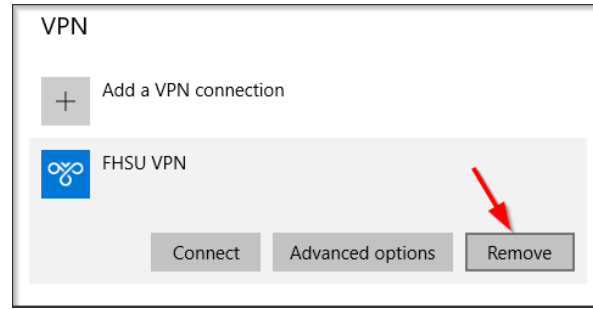

Removing Legacy FHSU VPN Connection

Windows 8/10

1. Press the Windows Key ()
2. Type **VPN** and select **Change virtual private networks (VPN)**
3. Click **FHSU VPN**
4. Click **Remove**
5. Confirm by clicking **Remove** again



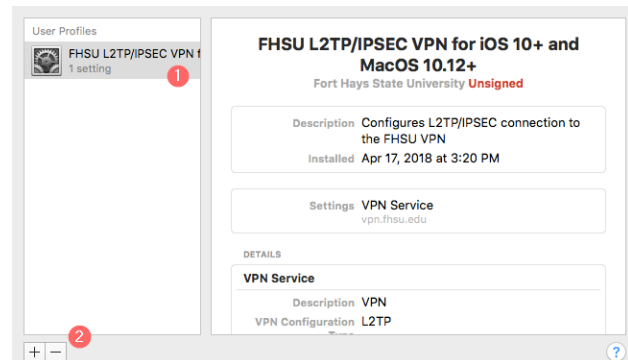
Windows 7

1. Press the Windows Key ()
2. Type **Network** and select **Network and Sharing Center**
3. Click **Change Network Adapter Settings** in the left pane
4. Right-click **FHSU VPN**
5. Click **Delete**

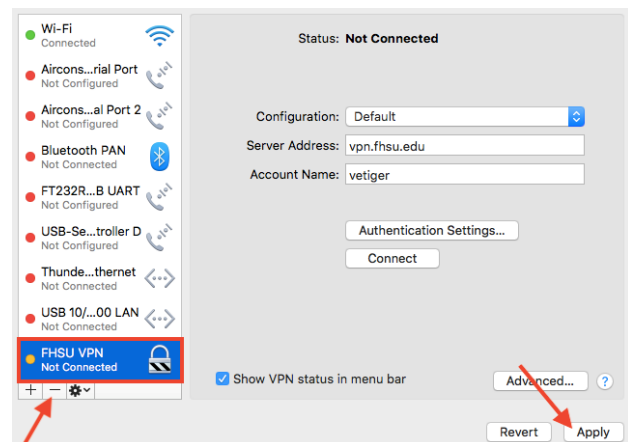
Mac OS X

1. Apple Menu > System Preferences > Profiles
2. Select **"FHSU L2TP/IPSEC..."** from the list
3. Click the remove (-) button.
4. Click **Remove** to confirm

If you don't have a profile, you can try removing it manually.



1. Apple Menu > System Preferences > Network
2. Select **"FHSU VPN"** from the list
3. Click the remove (-) button.
4. Click **Apply** to confirm



Removing Legacy FHSU VPN Connection

Apple iOS

1. Settings > General > Profile
2. Tap **FHSU L2TP/IPSEC VPN for iOS 10+ and MacOS 10.12+**
3. Tap **Remove Profile**
4. Enter your passcode
5. Tap **Remove**

If you don't have a profile, you can try removing it manually.

1. Settings > General > VPN
2. Tap the ⓘ button next to FHSU VPN
3. Tap **Delete VPN**
4. Tap **Delete** again to confirm
