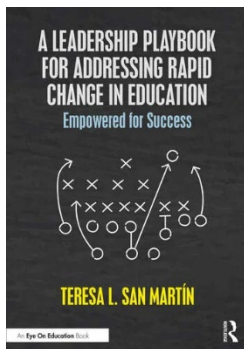

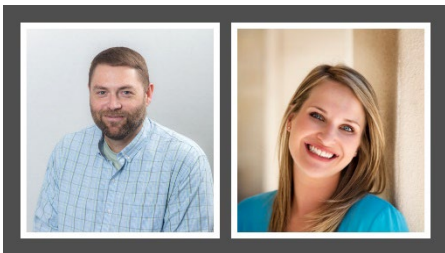
Fort Hays State University launched a historic affiliation partnership with North Central Kansas Technical College and Northwest Kansas Technical College in July of this year. This fall, 14,617 students, including 8,998 Kansans, are enrolled at one of the three Fort Hays institutions. Enrollment at Fort Hays Tech | North Central is up 3.1 percent, with 987 online and on-campus students in Hays and Beloit.
