Traveling Trophy

- The Student Affairs Traveling Trophy was presented to the HR Office.
- SALT wanted to let the HR staff know the division appreciates everything HR has been doing while being short staffed.

VP Update

- Board of Regents Update
 - Reverse transfer revisions are now mandating everyone use the clearing house
 - The First 15 task force has been appointed by the regents to figure out how every school district in Kansas be able to have their students obtain 15 college credit hours at no cost. The classes have been predetermined.
 - Complete College America will be meeting February 15. FHSU will have five reps attending.
 - Courses were approved for system-wide transfer.
 - Housing rates were approved for 2025-26.
- CSAO Meeting
 - VP's will have breakfast with the Board of Regents in January.
 - Board of Regents met with SGA reps in December.
- Holiday Gathering
 - Joey thanked the committee for their work in planning the Holiday Gathering.
 - SALT has discussed attendance at the Holiday Gathering.
 - SALT decided the Holiday Gathering event will be held the week after finals week. Students will no longer be invited to the event and offices will remain open.
 - Student employees will receive a separate gift.
 - Professional staff will receive a gift by attending the holiday gathering. If staff do not attend, they will not receive a gift. Attendance will not be required.
 - The Holiday Gathering will no longer be assessed.
- VP for Economic & Workforce Development Search Committee
 - Joey will be chairing the search committee for the new position that will be part of the ELT team. The position will report directly to Tisa Mason.
- Curtis Hammeke, Director of Athletics, has announced his retirement. Joe Bain will chair the search, and Joey will serve on the committee.

- Student Success Update
 - Jill, Joey, and Barb met with Dr. Mason. Dr. Mason agreed with the structure proposal.
 - The structure will be shared with the campus community in January, but no names will be included. A time period will be determined for the university to provide comments about the structure proposal to Joey and Jill. There will be no open forums. No details about titles or staffing will be shared.
 - Once the reorg has been finalized there will be a three-year freeze on reorganized positions. Tisa has asked Jill and Joey to develop a metrics to determine if the reorg worked at the end of the three years.
- Year End Reviews
 - HR sent an email with the instructions on launching the 2024 evaluations.
 - Joey would like departments to have reviews completed and in the approval process by January 24, 2025, so they can be approved by the AVPs and VP.
- ERM Committee
 - An Enterprise Risk Management Committee has been formed by the President. Joe Bain is chairing the 21-member committee.
 - The Board of Regents is requiring each institution to have an ERM committee.
 - The committee will develop a plan for all types of risk variables across campus.
- Spring 2025 Teaching Loads
 - Make sure AVP's are aware of staff in the division who are teaching for the Spring 2025 semester.

Enrollment Leadership Update

- Intersession is up a few students over last year.
- Spring 2025 enrollment is up slightly on-campus and online.
