The office assists students with interpreting university policies and degree requirements, fulfilling transcript requests, or verifying current enrollment for insurance purposes. The office maintains the quality, accuracy, safekeeping, and confidentiality of all records of current and former students.

- Simplified Hays High Concurrent Enrollment process for the student by administratively performing all registrations in the Registrar's Office

- Implemented Application for Admission and Admit Home rewording and simplification
- ❖ New and redesigned application packets are now being sent
- ❖ Further streamlined current new and continuous student onboarding
- ❖ Tested early matriculation and subsequent onboarding of new students
- Helped implement Core and transition to KBOR SW Gen Ed programs in Workday for students
- ❖ Aided Provost's Office in launching CourseLeaf catalog
- ❖ Trained personnel at the department level regarding how to use the newly created course section creation and approval process
- ❖ In conjunction with Tech Services, implemented National Student Clearinghouse Enrollment Reporting data cleanup and data conversion processes
- ❖ Reduced inbound external transcript processing timeline using Brainware
- Developed and implemented a process to merge historical objects with active student record objects in Workday to produce transcripts and articulate data


